



How to apply for a Postal Vote Easy Read Guide





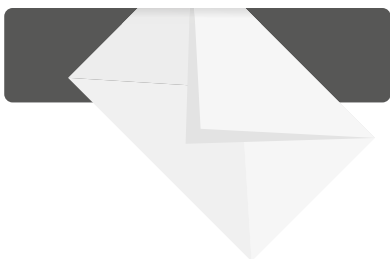
The island wide election is in October 2020.

If you have registered to vote, you can choose to vote by post.



This means the ballot paper will be posted to your home.



You can fill in the ballot paper in the comfort of your own home, and in your own time.

This guide will help you apply for a postal vote.

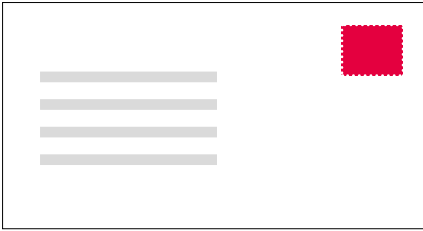
